arcurio® is manufacturing this model of the attractive Chevrolet Pickup 1931 according to the company's own plans.

In May of 1931, when this Chevrolet Pickup was first introduced to the public, the competition was shocked and completely caught off guard.

The technical parameters of this pickup dwarfed anything similar available in the marketplace at reasonable prices. The car enjoyed maximum popularity for a long period of time. Even years after its discontinuation it was still highly popular among special enthusiasts, who occasionally molded it into monstrous Dragsters, to be seen on predominantly American roads until today.

The technical parameters were impressive for the public of 1931: The 6-cylinder engine generated 46 HP, with which Chevy reached a speed of 80 Km/h. The model was also called Chevy Pickup 1 1/2, because the maximum load it could carry amounted to 1.5 tons, a heavy load for a car of this size at that time.

Composition of Materials used

There are 3 different types of prime European woods used in the model: Alder, Maple and Beech. The wood itself is left completely natural, it is not painted or otherwise chemically treated. The various parts of the model are assembled with great care and perfection in order to achieve a good matching of the wood-grains. This high quality model of the pickup is composed of 86 parts

Particular features of the model

All arcurio® Oldtimer Models are handmade. The wood employed is carefully selected and matched according to the individual wood-grains. The model series are of limited number. Each model is crafted individually and therefore carries a brass plate with its engraved model type and production number.

The Chevy Pickup Model displays the following special features:

- Turning spoke wheels;
- Movable side doors with door locks;
- Loading space to be raised.

Do it yourself-Kit

- Kit consisting of 58 parts;
- Surface with a smooth finish ready for final conservation, for instance by the use of natural olive oil;
- Approx. 4-5 hours of assembly-time;
- Options to individualize the model are available.

Size

The Model is 38 cm long, 16 cm high and 14 cm wide, it is produced at a scale of 1:12 and is supplied in a sumptuous, wooden engraved box, serving as a garage.
