## Horch 853A Sportcabrio

arcurio® is manufacturing this model of the legendary Horch 853A according to the company's own plans and with a license of AUDI Tradition using prime European wood.

In February of 1935 the original car was first presented to the public at the Berlin Automobile Exhibition. Between the beginning of 1935 and September of 1937 the company delivered 627 of these remarkably beautiful and well built Convertibles. At the time the price tag was 14,900 Reichsmark.

To build large, strong and good quality cars was August Horch's objective, and he succeeded without exemption. His 8-cylinders from Zwickau were, and still are, technical as well as design masterpieces. Footnote: Horch later became Audi (horch in German is audi in Latin).

### Composition of Materials used

There are 4 different types of wood used in the model: Alder, Ash, Maple, and Beech. The wood itself is natural and not painted or otherwise chemically treated. The various parts of the

model are assembled with great care and perfection in order to achieve a good matching of the wood-grains. This high quality arcurio® model is made of 112 handmade parts.



### Particular Features of the Model

All arcurio® Oldtimer Models are handmade. The wood employed is carefully selected and matched according to the individual wood-grains.

This stunning replica is produced in the very limited edition. Each model is crafted individually and therefore carries

a brass plate with its engraved model type and production number. The Horch 853A Sportcabriolet model displays the following special features:

- Hood to be opened
- Side doors and rear trunk to be opened
- Cob-wheel functional front wheel steering
- Review mirror mounted on spare wheels
- Engraved „H“- Emblem
- 2 spare wheels mounted on fenders

### Size

The model is 45 cm long, 13 cm high and 17 cm wide; it is produced at a scale of 1:12 and is supplied in a valuable, wooden engraved box, serving as a garage.
